The applicant must:

- Be an African American male senior attending high school in Prince William or Stafford County School Districts and planning to attend a four year accredited college or university
- Have a representative of his school send a copy of the applicant's transcript to: Woodbridge (VA) Alumni Chapter, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., P.O. Box 6340, Woodbridge VA 22195 postmarked **not later than April 5, 2010.**
- Have participated in extracurricular school and community activities while in high school
- Submit evidence of acceptance to an accredited college or university for the Fall of 2010
- Complete all application form requirements (i.e., Provide information requested, attach a one page essay, and two letters of recommendation –at least one from a school representative)
- Have application packet post marked not later than **April 5, 2010.**
